### Call For Nominations:

Nominations are open for the following positions (2023 Council Year commences at the AGM):

- President [2023 & 2024 – two year term]
- Treasurer [2023 & 2024 – two year term]
- National Representative(s) [2023 & 2024 & 2025 – three year term]

The full term of office is two years, with a maximum of three consecutive terms. The exception to this is the National Representative position, which is a three-year term, based on recent changes to the duration of National Council terms.

- Nominations *indicating the position being sought must be made in writing and must include a signed declaration by the nominee themselves.*
- Nominations *should be maximum 150 words, including a brief biography and a motivation statement.*
- *Please send nominations to Louise Mason, CESBC Administrator, at [cesbc.louise.mason@gmail.com](mailto:cesbc.louise.mason@gmail.com). Nominations must be received no less than **ten days** prior to the date of the AGM.*
- *Nominations may also be made from the floor at the AGM so long as the nominee is present or has indicated in writing their willingness to be considered for a specific position.*

*In addition, the following appointed positions are also vacant and can be shared roles:*

- **Northern Regional Coordinator(s)** *(suited to CESBC members who live in northern British Columbia)*
- **Student & Emerging Evaluators Coordinator(s)** *– no current coordinators*
- **Lower Mainland Co-Coordinator(s)** *– currently one coordinator in the role (suited to CESBC members who live in or near the Lower Mainland)*
- **Vancouver Island Co-Coordinator(s)** *– currently one coordinator in the role (suited to CESBC members who live in or near Victoria)*
